

INFORMATION SHEET: Cambodia

Cambodia has a rich and complex legacy, but a recent history of war and poverty has scarred the nation. In the last few decades, Cambodia has worked hard to transform its economy.

That growth, however, has been threatened by the double disasters of COVID-19 and climate change. Almost 20% of Cambodians live below the poverty line, earning less than \$3 per day, and rising food and energy prices may cause that number to grow.

Cambodians like Hak Nhy and her husband Kim Dorn have struggled to get by and rarely have enough to eat from their corn and rice harvest.

Your CROP Hunger Walk supports classes where Nhy learns the best methods to grow vegetables, compost fertilizer, and
