Host a simple hands-on CWS Kits assembly project as part of the Walk Day experience.



Assemble **CWS Kits** at your CROP Hunger Walk. It's an easy way for Walkers to work together and make an even bigger impact at the Walk. You can put kits together as people gather to Walk or assemble kits after they have completed the Walk.

Together, your community can create kits filled with essential supplies that offer comfort, dignity and care to neighbors facing difficult times.

First Things First

Choose a kit. Along with your Walk planning committee, decide what type of kit(s) you would like to assemble. CWS currently offers four types of kits:

- Hygiene Kits
- School Kits
- Period Packs (menstrual hygiene kits)
- Cleanup Buckets

Get What You Need

The easiest way to get started is with **CWS Kits Party Packs**.

We'll send everything you need:

- ✓ Supplies to assemble the kits
- ✓ Clear instructions
- ✓ Prepaid FedEx shipping labels

Assemble Your Kits

As Walkers gather, either before or after the Walk, invite them to help assemble the kits. Provide information about CWS Kits and how the kits are used.

Make the Kits Assembly fun by:

- Playing music
- Setting up simple packing stations
- Inviting youth groups and teams to help
- Celebrating what your community creates together

When Walkers are finished packing, hand out “Thank You for Walking Today” flyers and encourage them to host a Kits Packing Event. **Each kit is a simple reminder to someone that they are not alone.**

One Last Thing

When the kits are complete, simply seal the boxes, attach the prepaid FedEx shipping labels and send them back to CWS.

That’s it.
